Award Criteria:

- Nominees must be Floridian either by birth or by permanent residency and domicile
- Nominees must have demonstrated commitment to the highest ethical standards
- Nominees must have a sustained record of accomplishment
- Nominees must be living
- The *Spirit of Community Award* is limited to one person per lifetime per category
- Nominations must be received in the Commission office by close of business on August 31, 2021.
- The following criteria are utilized in reviewing and judging the nominations:
 1. The nominee gives freely and unselfishly by volunteering her or his time to community activities, even if volunteerism includes services above and beyond paid position of non-profit organization;
 2. The nominee inspires others and acts as a role model;
 3. The nominee has a positive impact on the direction and success of community projects, programs or individuals;
 4. The nominee improves the lives of others.

Please provide two references from individuals who are knowledgeable of the nominee's achievements and character, and are from the community served.
